On Tuesday, October 2 from 7:15 to 8pm at City Hall you will have the opportunity to take action and help show your continued support for the Contract Negotiation Team's efforts to help acquire a fair agreement. In order to show the City, the Council, and the people of Redmond that RCHEA is a strong, united group of hard working, dedicated employees, we, the RCHEA Board, are asking that RCHEA members attend the City Council meeting on Tuesday, October 2 and stand together in Council Chambers while our Chairperson, Denine Garrison, addresses the Council during the Items from the Audience portion of the meeting.

The Council meeting starts at 7:30pm, and Items from the Audience is at the top of the agenda. We are asking you to arrive at 7:15pm, sit together with your coworkers in a show of support, stand together while Denine addresses the Council, and then exit quietly together as a group at the completion of her statement.
